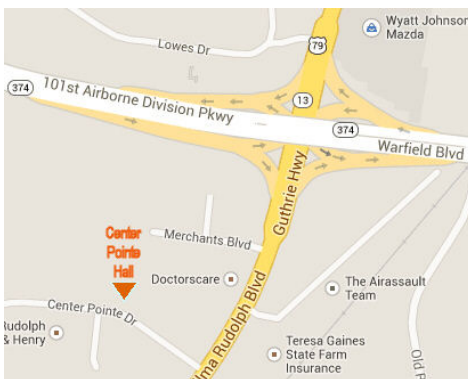

appropriate amount** to P.O. Box 3569, Clarksville, TN 37043-3569.

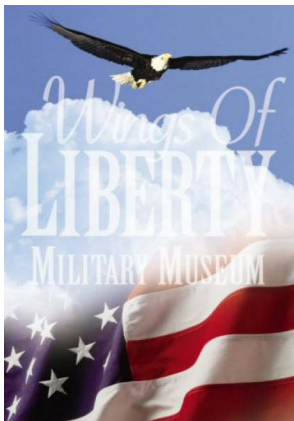
PRESIDENT'S COMMENTS

We began 2014 with the installation of our new officers two weeks ago, but our priorities for support of our local community had been established two months earlier.

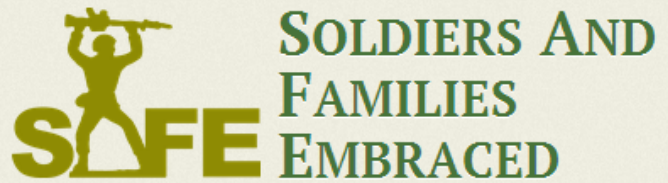

Our number-one priority for 2014 is to seek new funding sources for the *Wings of Liberty Museum* by acting as a third-party advocate for the Fort Campbell Historical Foundation.
